Your student has been working on a required portfolio during this school year. This portfolio is created in language arts classes, with social studies and other classes also contributing projects. This "identity book" will contain the following:

One of the chapters requires that a parent, or grandparent or older sibling write a short biographical sketch of the student's life due on April 22.
